Thank you for attending the Public Consultation Meeting for noise abatement procedures for the circuit pattern held on Monday, August 31, 2015.

Your feedback is an important step in the process of preparing the airport's submission to Transport Canada, as the airport seeks approval to alter the current circuit pattern. We will be presenting the noise abatement procedures to Transport Canada and your comments will be included in the submission. Currently, the airport is formalizing documentation, as well as assembling results from consultations with aviation stakeholders. After information and data has been finalized, it will be submitted to Transport Canada where the decision will be made in regards to the new circuit proposal.

The information you provided in regard to the proposed circuit change will be documented and submitted to Transport Canada as part of the noise abatement process. Other comments and concerns will be reviewed and a response will be provided.

The community's strong desire to establish a noise committee is of value to the airport, as we feel forming a committee is exceptionally important and congruent with the desires of the airport. The airport has been working diligently over the last four months to go through the required steps involved in forming a noise committee. Airport staff is currently working on the terms of reference, as well as the procedures to involve community members.
