Dear Residents:

This letter has been written to provide an update on the status of the noise mitigation objectives at the Peterborough Airport.

Peterborough Airport has submitted the documentation to request noise abatement procedures for the Airport circuit pattern to Transport Canada, as to the Advisory Circular (AC) No. 302-002 for Implementation of New or Amended Noise Abatement Procedures. Transport Canada will be reviewing the documentation and will provide their decision on the proposed circuit change.

Airport Staff have prepared the draft documentation to form a Noise Liaison Group which will help in sharing information between the Airport, community residents, and Airport tenants and users. The Group will be formed through an application process which is expected to commence in the near future with the first meeting to be held early in 2016.

Airport staff have dedicated their efforts over the past few months to working through the process for noise abatement procedures to be submitted to Transport Canada and preparing terms and procedures for the Noise Liaison Group.

Next steps will be to address additional questions and concerns that were provided on forms submitted from the August 31, 2015 public consultation with a response from City Staff to follow.
